

Full Sermon Transcript:
Arranged Marriages in the Bible
May 3, 2025

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Let's pray. Lord Heavenly Father, Almighty God, Creator of heaven and earth, we thank you, Lord, for your faithfulness of getting us through this week and all these many years that you have preserved us and kept us. And you have called us and chosen us for this time and for this purpose. Thank you for entrusting us for this work. We do accept your holy anointing and blessing on these services and on this message we're about to receive, as I know that you have given me powerful and divine confirmations of the Holy Scripture. We accept your anointing, we embrace it, for your word shall not return void nor vain, but shall accomplish your purpose in heaven and on earth. We accept it and we proclaim it in the holy and mighty name of Jesus. Amen. You may be seated.

Let's turn to Genesis 24.

For people listening for the first time, you will definitely be challenged today. Most people, their religious beliefs are based upon their culture of where they were born, what their parents and grandparents taught them, and what the local church on the corner taught them. And if you were born and raised in India, then your family are most likely to be Hindu. If you were born in the Middle East, other than Israel, perhaps even Israel, you may have been born and raised as a Muslim or in Israel, perhaps in Judaism. China, you may be an atheist or you may have been involved and raised in Buddhism. In Utah, you may have been raised as a Mormon. In the northern United States, you may have been raised as a Catholic or Lutheran or other versions of Catholicism. Or in the southern United States, you may have been born as a Baptist or a Pentecostal. And so on and so on and so on, according to local regions and cultures, religions that you was/were raised with. For the most part, most people all around the world blindly accept the teachings of their families and of their culture. And they never have a second thought that their religion and their teachings might be wrong.

In fact, they will strongly defend and fight for that religion that they was raised with, even though they have never even attempted to honestly, sincerely examine if that was even the truth.

But they will fight for it tooth and nail. And really, it's based upon pride that how dare we even think that our parents and grandparents or local culture might be wrong.

But Revelation 12, verse 9, does teach us that Satan has deceived the entire world.

The entire world has been deceived.

The Bible teaches us that we will be hated for righteousness sake, that we will be hated because we love the one and true God, that the world loves itself and its sin and its deception, that the world loves a lie and will heap unto themselves teachers that tickle their ears of what they want to hear.

That is very clearly what the Bible says. Amen. If we claim that we want the truth, which everybody claims, but if we truly want the truth, then we will read the entire Bible.

We will seek out the truth. We will study the Scriptures, even as the Bible says that the one group of people, the Bereans in that chapter of Acts, that they studied the Scriptures to see if these things were true.

The Bible says to rightly divide the Word of God and to study, to make ourselves approved to God, worthy to God. Amen.

The Bible says to prove all things, talking about Scriptural things, to prove it, not just blindly accept it or blindly follow the crowds.

The entire world is deceived. That's not going to change until the final year of the Great Tribulation.

If we read the Bible, understand it and believe it. So in these sermons, you will be challenged.

But I simply ask that you hear me out, consider all the Bible verses that we're going to cover today, all the points, all the principles, before you make your final conclusion.

You have to consider the entire equation, all the facts, before you can make a true opinion or conclusion, even as the Bible does teach us to hear it out. Amen.

It's good to see M joining us as well and other people around the world.

Today's topic is arranged marriages. The parents arranging who their sons and daughters will marry.

That sounds very strange, weird, odd, and even wrong to people in the modern Western world where their theology and their culture and their behavior is marrying anyone you want to.

Most of the time it's based upon lust. She's pretty and I want to have sex with her as soon as I can.

She's got tattoos like I do and she likes to work cars. I like to work on cars and she likes to ride motorcycles like I like to ride motorcycles.

And therefore I love her and I will marry her until it all collapses. And then you marry a second one and a third one and she does the same thing.

And both people, man and woman both, they're married and divorced three times a piece, four times, five times.

And that's everyone in modern Western culture. How dare we think that the elders might know better or who might be our better spouse.

Very strange and weird to modern Western people. But what does the Bible teach? Let's take an honest examination of this.

Starting in Genesis 24, verse 2, we're reading from the Alpha and Omega Bible but you're welcome to follow along in any translation that you have in front of you.

Verse 2, And Abraham said to his servant, the outer of his house, who had rule over all his possessions, Put your hand under my thigh and I will adjoin you by the Lord.

In other words, I'm going to make you swear to God, the Theos of Heaven and Earth and the Theos of Earth, that you take not a woman or a wife for my son Isaac from the daughters of the Canaanites with whom I dwell in the midst of them.

But you will go instead to my country, which was Syria, from which Abraham came out of Macedonia, which was Syria more specifically, where I was born, and to my tribe.

And you would take from there a woman for my son Isaac. The instruction is clear that Abraham was given instructions to his servant to find a wife for his son Isaac.

Let's turn to Genesis 29, verse 15. Another example, later on in history, you have Abraham, Isaac, and then Jacob. So now you come to that third generation.

And Laban, who was a Syrian man, but related to this family, said to Jacob, Surely you shall not serve me for nothing, because you are my brother that is a kin, not brother-brother, but brethren.

And I want to change that in a way to, yeah, we'll change that in the AOB Bible to make it where people can understand it so people are not confused.

It's just a better translation to put that you are my brethren or my kin. Tell me what your reward is to be.

And Laban said, or had, he had two daughters. The name of the elder was Leah, and the name of the younger was Rachel.

And the eyes of Leah was weak, but Rachel was beautiful in appearance and exceedingly fair in appearance.

And Jacob loved Rachel and said, I will serve you seven years for your younger daughter, Rachel.

And Laban said to him, it is better that I should give her to you than that I should give her to another man.

Dwell with me. So we know what happened. He did work seven years to marry the girl of his choice, Rachel. But yet when it came the wedding night, he went into the tent to have sex with the woman.

There was a veil, whatever, over her head. He didn't know who it was. It was actually Leah. So he was married to Leah instead.

And then he had to work seven more years to attain to purchase Rachel from the father of these two girls. Amen.

So obviously there is a father here that is in charge of who his daughters will marry.

Generation after generation, not just one generation, that this continued.

Let's go over to Genesis 38, Verse 6. And Judah took a woman or wife for his son called Er, his firstborn.

And this woman's name is Tamar. We know that that is an ancestor to Jesus, Tamar was.

But Judah arranged this marriage for his son. Generation after generation, that this continued.

Chapter 41 now. And don't worry, we will get to the New Testament as well eventually.

In Genesis 41, Verse 45. And Pharaoh called the name of Joseph, and I can't even begin to pronounce that. They gave him an Egyptian name and gave him also his daughter, the priest, to woman or to wife for Joseph. We know that Joseph embraced this. As we read each and every one of these Biblical accounts and historical accounts, none of these men said, no, I won't do it. I want to find a girl that I can fall in love with naturally without being told what to do. I'm my own man. I'm my own person. I'm my own being. It's my life. It's my life. I do it my way. I want to do what I want to do. None of these men had that reaction, but rather in every case, generation after generation, these men accepted this as the way that it goes. It's just the way that it goes. Amen. Most people would say this is ancient culture and Middle Eastern culture, and therefore it has nothing to do with us today. Let's keep reading.

Exodus 22, Verse 16. And if anyone, it says deceive a virgin, but that's a poor translation. So we're going to perfect that translation and change the word deceive to the word seduce. If anyone seduce a virgin that is not promised in marriage and lie with her, that means have sex with her, he shall surely endow her for a wife to himself. But if her father positively refuse, absolutely refuse, and will not give consent to give her to him for a wife, he shall pay composition to her father according to the amount of the Diary of Virgins. So very clear that the dad has the absolute control about who she would marry and not marry. Even if she has already had sex, even though sex is marriage in the eyes of God, there is still a requirement for that dad to give his blessing and permission because that girl belongs to that man, that dad, until she is given away to another man, and then she belongs to that man, the husband, according to Scripture. Now we said earlier, I just mentioned that most people are going to say, this is ancient Middle Eastern culture, has nothing to do with us. But this verse is actually the Word of God, not the words of Moses, the words of Joseph, the words of Abraham, the words of Jacob. But this particular verse is actually the command of God Almighty, His instruction, His command on how things are to be conducted, exercised in life, the way it's supposed to be. And this is not specific to the Israelites either, but to human sexuality, marriages. This is going beyond culture when it is God Himself instructing us how He wants us to do things.

Let's go to the book of Judges, Judges chapter 1. Page 164, in Judges chapter 1, starting in verse 12, And Caleb said, Whosoever shall strike the city of letters, and shall take it, I will give to him Ascha, my daughter, to wife, to be his wife. Now who is Caleb? Of course, we know that Caleb is one of only three men that God chose to preserve and keep alive that had crossed the Red Sea when they left Egypt. Only Caleb, Joshua, and Moses survived the 40 years as far as the original people that crossed the Red Sea. So this is a man that God honored and was one of the chosen, you could say, one of the more righteous Israelites. Generation after generation, this is the way it continued to be with the people that were listening to God and following God and God's way of life.

Look at chapter 14, in Judges 14, verse 1. And Samson went down to that town and saw a woman in that town of the daughters of the Philistines. And he went up and told his father and his mother, and said, I have seen a woman in this town of the daughters of the Philistines, and now take her to me for a wife. He doesn't go out and just start dating her, but rather he goes to his parents and says, get me this girl. So then, of course, we know that those parents would have went to her parents, her dad, gotten the permission, and arranged the marriage. That's how it would have happened. Generation after generation, most people consider Samson a man of sin, but he is listed in Hebrews 11 in the Hall of Fame of the devout, devoted, righteous people that obeyed God, served God, and are examples to us to how we are to live. Samson is in that list, and the Bible never condemns Samson for everything or anything that he did, despite the fact that

traditional, modern, Western, lost, deceived, Pharisee Christians want to say that every little thing that Samson did was a sin, that he was a transgressor, that he was lost, all these things, and yet the Bible never says any of that whatsoever at all, but has him as being part of the Hall of Fame of faith in Hebrews 11.

Now let's go to the book of 1 Samuel 18, verse 20.

Talking about this woman, Michael, the daughter of Saul, loved David and was told to Saul, and the thing was pleasing in his eyes, and Saul said, I will give her to him, to David, and she shall be a stumbling block to him.

So we know that Saul did not mean well in this, but it was a trap, but nevertheless we know that Saul gave his daughter to David, gave his daughter to David, and David was a man that was after God's own heart, the Bible says.

The Bible says the only thing that he did transgress is only in the other woman, not this woman, Bathsheba, because she was already married and he arranged for the murder of her husband.

Basically, not murder, but basically murder, setting him up to die on purpose. So that is murder in the eyes of God.

But it says that's the only thing that David transgressed about. Now we know that actually David would have had other sins in his life, even though the Bible says that was the only thing he transgressed about.

We have to use common sense. We all sin as teenagers. We all sin as young adults, and every one of us have more than one sin. Amen.

We have to use common sense. Use your brain. Use the intelligence that God gave you. So when it says that's the only thing he transgressed about, it's really talking about that was the only major thing that he transgressed about.

But we all have these other, smaller sins. Absolutely, David would have been in the same situation.

But as far as this right here goes, David, who is mostly a very righteous man after God's own heart, he doesn't say no.

I want to fall in love with her naturally or anything like this, but he accepts it and embraces it. Amen.

And of course, he does see it as a privilege, as a benefit, as a promotion, as a way of favor from the king.

He does see it, of course, by human nature, as a financial power play that there are more than just one reason to get married.

If we step outside of modern, Western programming, brainwashing, and tradition that's only 100 years old, if we step out of this modern, new generation that we are in from this past 100, 150 years and go back only 200 years ago, we see that this ancient way of life wasn't just 3,000 years ago and 2,000 years ago, but it was even as recent as 200 years ago in the United States.

Even that recently, 200 years ago in the United States, that this was a common theme in England, in the British Empire, this was a common theme.

And a lot of the modern Western programming and brainwashing is relatively new about a million things that we think is normal and right and wrong.

A lot of it is relatively very, very new and recent thinking that came down from the Seventh-day Adventist Church cult in the 1800s and the Baptist and Pentecostal cults in the 1800s.

And a lot of those new cults that developed and were invented by women and men in the 1800s and early 1900s is the root cause of a lot of our modern Western programming and culture.

Let us keep reading. We will get to the New Testament.

But first, let's go to Jeremiah. Jeremiah, and in the AOB, this is going to be chapter 36, but if you do not have the Alpha Bible, this is going to be chapter 29 because the chapters of Jeremiah are in different arrangements in the oldest Bibles. The Alpha and Omega Bible is based upon the oldest Bible manuscripts available and therefore is a different chapter arrangement for the book of Jeremiah.

So in the Alpha and Omega Bible, we're turning to Jeremiah 36, which is page 515, but if you're in any other translation, then this is going to be Jeremiah chapter 29. Page 434. And we're looking at verse 6.

Verse 6 says, Take you wives and the God or conceive or give birth to sons and daughters and take wives for your sons and give your daughters to husbands and be multiplied and be not diminished.

The context here is God's instruction and this is the Word of God, God Himself speaking to the Israelites at the beginning of their 70 years of captivity under the Babylonian Empire, King Nebuchadnezzar and his descendants.

Nevertheless, this is the Word of God and it matches what God told an entirely different generation of people.

God does not change. God is the same yesterday, today and tomorrow. In these different generations, He continues to tell His people to... That the parents are to arrange the marriages and to make for sure their sons and daughters do get married and have babies.

That's the will of God even as He told Adam and Eve to multiply, to have babies. Even as the Bible says that a man leaves his father and mother and he is married to his wife and they become one flesh.

In fact, let's think about what I just said. Adam and Eve. That also, of course, was an arranged marriage. The original man and woman on this earth, God could have, if He wanted to, He could have put that man and woman separately and have them bump into each other in the forest and fall in love naturally and by their own free will and by their choice and allow them to reject one another.

But no, He put them together right from the start from her very first day of existence.

She was with Adam, meant to be his sidekick, meant to be his partner, his soulmate.

And what about that word soulmate? The person that you are meant to be with. If you end up with marrying your soulmate, the person that you were created to live life with, we wouldn't be having this divorce after divorce after divorce after divorce.

The original soulmates, our ancestors, our great great great great grandfather and grandmother, Adam and Eve, was an arranged marriage.

Let's go, there's another chapter of Jeremiah, let's go to Jeremiah 6, verse 16.

And this is going to be the same chapter in all versions of the Bible, Jeremiah chapter 6, verse 16.

Thus say of Jesus, stand you in the way and see and ask or seek out the old path of Jesus and see what is the good way and walk in it and use to find purification for your souls.

But they said we will not walk in them in those old ways. God Almighty is an old school guy, old school.

If we want to get close to God and obey him and know his mind and his heart and his will, we should seek out, look for that old path, the ancient ways, not the modern ways, not the modern culture.

But the ancient culture is more in line with God and the Middle Eastern culture is more in line with God.

God is very much ancient Middle Eastern mindset to the mind of God. That is very very true, extremely true.

If you want to get close to God and know his will, you have to go back to the ancient Middle Eastern mindset.

God will not change, he will always be old fashioned. Now let's go to the New Testament.

John chapter 6 verse 44. Jesus says this, he says, No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him or invites him and I will raise him up on the last day.

Jesus is our bridegroom, our marriage partner. We are the bride of Christ. And we will not be part of that marriage supper and marry Christ unless his Father arrange the marriage to us.

We will not be part of the bride unless the Father is the one that arranges it and draws us to him.

You can't get any more new covenant than the marriage supper itself. And even though this is not a sexual marriage and not a fleshly carnal marriage, it is a real marriage with a real husband, bridegroom, bride, a real marriage festival, a real marriage ceremony, and is the most intense and perfect picture of love and God's will and God's perfected design in us. And the spirit and the flesh, the physical realm, are divinely connected. The human mind and the heavenly mind.

What is on earth is what is in heaven. What is in heaven is what is on earth. We cannot separate the flesh and the spirit. If this is his will for his son and the divine marriage, then this is his will for us as his sons and daughters, sons of God, daughters of God in our relationships.

What about love? What about love? In some of these instances throughout the scripture, we actually do read the word love, that they actually loved each other.

And when we think of all these different arranged marriages that we have read one after another after another, we never think of any of those marriages as being dysfunctional, wrong, unethical, unmoral, or ending in divorce.

Except, of course, we don't like the fact that Laban deceived Jacob and had him to marry Leah first.

But with that exception, otherwise, Rachel was a good thing. And many of these other cases, examples, were good things, that the result was good.

What is the fruit of this if this was practiced today? We should always consider, is there going to be bad fruit?

Is there going to be evil fruit? Is there any good fruit? What would be the fruit, the result, if we'd still practiced this today? If we take an honest, sincere examination of it, one of the fruits would be no virgins.

Every guy, every gal, everyone would have a spouse, a husband, a wife. If you did not have 30-year-old virgins, 40-year-old virgins, 50-year-old virgins, you wouldn't have it.

Everyone would have a spouse, a partner, a soulmate. As I said earlier, a lot of times people get married based upon temporary lust and carnal things like, she has the same tattoo as me, she likes motorcycles, and I like motorcycles, or

she's pretty, and that's as far as it goes.

But if it's arranged by the parents, the parents are going to be looking at the character of the family, the police record, your school record, things you've done, things that the neighbors know you've done, the things that the community knows you have done and not done, whether you're a good guy or a bad guy, a good girl or a bad girl, they're going to be looking at all these things.

Parents, on both sides, the parents of the girl, the parents of the guy, both sides, both families are going to be looking and being really very strict on who they match up, and being older and wiser, they're going to make better decisions about who you should be with and not be with.

There would be no virgins, more children, people would be married earlier in life instead of waiting until they're 40 and 50 years old to marry, there would be more children, more grandchildren, therefore, when a person gets old, they would not have to be thrown into the nursing home, because they don't have anyone to take care of them, they would have children, they would have grandchildren, they would have more family to love them, to take care of them as they get old.

The result would also be that more and more and more the man would be the one to die first, which it is already for the most, most of the time it is the man that dies first, but if we practice the arranged marriages, it would be even more true and more often that the man would die first, leaving the widow behind so that the widow, in living in a home of widows together as a team under a pastor's guidance, as the original biblical nuns' convent before the Catholic Church took that ideal and did it for themselves.

But it was a biblical thing as in the Bible, and it was the way of ancient life, the way that the original first century church did, and it was the way that the Old Testament Jews did, but doing that practice and returning to that, you would have these older widows that devote the rest of their lives after their husband's death to prayer and to service, to God, to the church, to God's church, to the service of the church, to the service of God, you would have this instead of marriage after marriage after marriage for these women, you would have these older women, these widows, as devout, devoted to prayer and fasting and to the service of the younger women and children, as prophecies and deaconesses serving the church and serving God.

My personal experience is that when the wives die first, the husbands go crazy, they lose their mind, and they start wandering the streets homeless.

Men cannot handle the death of their wife, like women can much more handle the death of their husband, because this is the way it's designed, is the way it's meant to be, the man is meant to die first.

This helps guarantee the natural realm, the natural design, the natural plan of God for the man to die first, because you would be starting out with the man being older, and it would come out that way.

There would be less divorce, less virgins, more children, marriages would last a lifetime, there would be better marriages arranged by the parents with wisdom, less repeat marriages, going marrying another, another, another, another, and preservation of the Israelite tribes and nations, because the parents would be arranging within your own tribal rather than outside your tribes.

We understand that in modern western society, it's almost impossible to live this.

In modern western society in the United States, it's almost impossible to live according to the original divine plan of God, that's the reality.

Therefore, we're not saying that it absolutely must be this way, we're not saying that, because we know that with modern brainwashing programming, we're all living in Babylon, it don't matter what nation you live in, we're all living in the Babylonian world, it's difficult to refine other parents that will agree to these arranged marriages.

But nevertheless, there's a lot of nations where they still do practice this across Africa and Asia, probably even parts of Mexico, probably Russia, China, I would say the majority of nations on earth probably still practice this, at least in regions and certain families, as this has really always been the way it has always worked for 6,000 years of humanity until only recent in these modern western upside down nations.

So if you live in a nation where this is more commonplace, then it is the best thing to do.

You also still need to practice this within the true church, you don't want to marry your sons and daughters off to cults, false Christians, Catholics.

You want to keep it in the true church. So that's another stumbling block, a hindrance is because the true church right now is almost non-existent.

The entire world is deceived, the entire world loves a lie and they love false religion and so it's hard to find another family in your own town and even within your nation that really wants to live according to God's divine will and the

way things are supposed to be.

So again we're not saying this is the way it must be, it's only that we're saying that we want to know what God's will is, we want to know how it was originally supposed to be and if the opportunity did arise, then we should take hold.

If such an opportunity was available to us, we would want to live within God's will, that's not always possible.

But we are an international ministry worldwide, different nations across the globe, so you never know, there may be someone in Algeria or another nation that will listen to us and say yes, this is possible for me and my family and my region, we can do this.

And we want those people to know we won't condemn you for following the divine plan, God bless you and bless your family.

We won't proclaim correct doctrine and not condemn people just because we don't understand it, we need to read the entire Bible and believe it and believe the words of God and whenever possible to follow his will. Amen.

Can you marry when it's not arranged by your parents? I believe that God makes exceptions. I believe that he gives us enough free will to where if we're raised in an upside down culture that's totally outside of his will, that he can still put our soulmate in our path that we would meet and marry without the parents being involved and still be within God's will.

But in an ideal world that if we wasn't under this Babylonian confusion, false religion and Pharisee laws that are not biblical, then we would be more free than what we are to live God's will.

Divine confirmations, two or three confirmations to confirm to me and therefore to you if you care about this.

But I know that God has confirmed to me that this ain't just my thinking and my will and my opinion because God has repeatedly confirmed this message to me.

One of the ways he confirmed it is last night I was watching the television show called Restaurant Impossible and the star of the show, the man that runs the show, he said that the couple that that particular episode was about that owned that restaurant, that that man and woman that they loved each other more than anybody he ever seen, more than anyone else he had ever seen in his life, that couple, that man and woman loved each other more than anyone else and they had been together since they were kids.

To arrange the marriage is most likely going to be families that live in the same community, that know each other, that go to the same school or home school together, you're raised together, you know each other from childhood, it's not a stranger, they don't have things hidden in their past that they're always going to hide from you, no surprises and friendship that starts earlier in life.

And you know each other, you know each other, whereas what I see very common in today modern western world, people get married and they live together for 20 years and they still don't know each other, they still don't know their husband or their wives favorite color after 20 years of marriage, they still don't know if their husband or if their wife even believes in God and they've been married 20 years, this is the insanity that we're dealing with in this modern upside down western culture, with arranged marriages you wouldn't be strangers.

Another confirmation is on this Jeremiah chapter 3 to 6 in the AOB chapter 29 and other translations, when I went to my Bible to find that scripture, my Bible was not opening at all, it was completely closed, I was opening it up and it was that page exactly, without having to flip not even one page, it opened right up exactly to that scripture, when I went to look at that scripture.

Even in the United States, even today in modern society there are a few groups that do still practice this, even though they're Babylonian groups, but it shows you that this is not just old culture, it's still practiced today like I said in Africa, Asia, the Middle East, but even in the United States among the Amish, which most people have very high respect for, the Amish are very well respected people, they still practice this and among the Jews even in the United States and the Orthodox and the fundamentalist, if I can say this right, fundamentalist Mormons, even though we know that they are a cult, but when I say fundamentalist Mormon I'm not talking about the Church of Latter Day Saints, but rather the older religion that still does the pornography, which we know is biblical and they still do the arranged marriage, which now we know also is biblical, so even though they're Babylonian just like all these other groups, they do have more truth than a lot of other groups, and they have this old path, way of life that does match scripture in these two areas of life that I just mentioned.

Okay, so I'm going to open up the chat room now for anyone that has questions, the chat room is not for people to say you're wrong, you're lost, you're deceived, you're a cult, but the chat room, the purpose is for people to glorify God, to edify one another, to encourage one another, to ask questions, to learn, if you have a sincere heart to learn, if you have

an honest sincere question, the chat room is available for you for that purpose, as well as if you would like to give a testimony for God of what God's done for you, ask for prayer, or if you have a prayer request, or if at this time you would want to sing a song for God, or share a dream or vision that you've had this week, or share a Bible verse that you've read this week that touched your heart that you think would be edifying for the Church, all of these are welcome.

Again, I invite whoever it is listening from India, I invite you to introduce yourself and let us know that you're listening.

Calm Adam, he has a question with polygamy, could the future wives also be arranged marriages?

Yes, they can be.

Brother R, you got anything to say or ask or do?

I've done a lot of thinking and research on this topic of arranged marriages, and one thing that's a really good heuristic for whether these are good laws or bad laws is, is it pro-life or anti-life?

And for the modern western system, all you have to do is look at the birth rates of these European Americans, South Korea, these civilizations, and see that they're below replacement, they're dying out because they aren't having enough families, they aren't having enough children.

Exactly. Amen. That is actually a major problem with the Israelite nations, is that we're dying out.

So this would help preserve the Israelite tribes, and this is one of the reasons God always did this, was to preserve the Israelite tribes. Amen.

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
