And we pray that this message has your anointing and presence and blessing and empowerment.

To help more people understand the truth and persevere and pass the test. This word will not be in vain.

It will accomplish your purpose here on earth as it is in heaven. Thy kingdom come.

We accept your anointing, your blessing, your help, and your presence. We pray for your help in filling your presence, hearing your voice, acknowledging your presence, and worshiping you during the sermon, during the testimonies, during each different part of the worship service.

Be strong in us. Help us to not quench your spirit. Help us to feel your closeness. That you're not a million miles away. That you're not just in heaven or in outer space or hiding behind a planet somewhere.

1 Thessalonians chapter 5. The subject today, on this day of Purim, March 3rd, 2026. In only one second, the entire world will change.

When I sent out, when I sent the notifications today, made the scheduling for the sermon, I put, can change, but it would be more appropriately stated as will, amen, will change.

In only one second, the entire world will change. Whether that's today or tomorrow, next week, next month, a year, two years, ten years.

Whenever it happens, it's going to only take a second. That's all it takes. Some people will be in their beds, asleep.

Other people in the bath or in the shower or at work or outdoors.

But wherever you're at, there'll be a drastic, immediate, unexpected change that would change the entire world.

It doesn't take two days or a month. It only takes one second. It's quick. It's sudden, sudden.

It therefore is very unexpected to the blind, to the world, to most Christians, because they're not truly saved, unfortunately.

To the entire world, for the most part in general, the entire world, lost and blind, is not expecting what we are expecting. Amen?

It only takes one second. Here in 1 Thessalonians 5 verse 3, while they are saying, peace and safety, then destruction

will come upon them suddenly, like labor pains upon a woman with child, and they will not escape. It comes upon them suddenly, because they're not expecting it. But we are watching, waiting, counting the days, expecting, because we follow Jesus in the truth. That's extremely rare. But the world in general, they're not expecting what we're expecting. And most of them don't even know the timeline, how God has given it, strongly and clearly and undeniably. There's really no excuse for people not knowing it. But this destruction will come upon them very quickly, suddenly. Amen?

Look at Luke 12, verse 40. You too be ready for the Son of Mankind is coming at an hour that you do not expect. The Christians have wrongly been told that that means that we will never expect it, that we cannot expect it, that even his own bride, even his own church, even his own followers will be called by surprise when he comes. But that's not what the Bible teaches. And that's not the truth. But rather it is the loss, even the lost Pharisees, lost religious leaders, teachers, the religious people of the world, of all denominations and religions. The majority of the world, to them he will come as a thief in the night. But a man never comes as a thief to his own bride. Amen? But to the world this will come unexpectedly. They will not expect it will come upon them suddenly. You know, it only takes a second for the entire world to change.

I'm not for sure how this says it in AOB, but we'll look at Proverbs 27. And that does remind me, whoever gets their first page number, 376.

For the people listening for the first time, because it definitely will be later this week, for the people listening for the first time, we're reading from the Alpha and Omega Bible, a restoration of the original scriptures based upon older manuscripts than what was used for other translations.

But you're welcome to try to follow along in other translations, because it does not use the demonic Assyrian Babylonian letter Y names.

Here in Proverbs 27 verse 1, it says, "Boast not of tomorrow if we do not know what the next day shall bring forth." Again, in general to the world, they don't know what tomorrow brings, but we do know what tomorrow brings. Because God reveals things to his own people, to his own bride. A man tells his wife most or some of his secrets. Amen.

A man will then share with his wife secrets that the rest of the world, the rest of the entire world, does not know what the wife knows.

That's the truth most of the time. Amen. Suddenness, suddenness, is not the exception in scripture, but rather it is the pattern. Amen.

Now God did send Jeremiah and other prophets to warn the people in advance, and he always does that.

But the people did not believe, and people never do believe. Noah, he was sent in advance.

Jeremiah was sent in advance, others were. But people did not believe, and therefore it still came unexpectedly to them. They did not expect it because they didn't believe the warnings, the messages of God.

Not that God did not send a warning, but rather because of their own stubbornness, their own hearts, their own wicked hearts.

Now let's look at Psalm 90, verse 12 And who knows how to number his days because of the fear of your wrath?

So manifest your right hand and those that are instructed in wisdom in the heart.

Other translations say, teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom.

Very different translation. Nevertheless, however you would translate it, there is a numbering of days.

In other words, we are mortal and not immortal, which is opposite of what the false churches teach and false religions teach.

The Bible teaches that we are mortal. It teaches that repeatedly throughout Scripture, Old and New Testament.

There is a numbering of our days. I think of Noah, Noah time, when God said, I will no longer put up with mankind, but I will limit the number of his days to 120 years.

And now it's even shorter than that. We know that Scripture talks about people acting like there's no end.

No coming of the Lord, no end of this world, no coming great tribulation. They're just living as if there's no major drastic changes coming.

It's just going to stay the same to them. They think it's just going to stay the same and even get better is their mentality. They crave the tickle the ear messages. The false peace, stability, security, world peace, tickle the ear messages.

Not the messages that provokes repentance. Not the messages that exposes their sins.
Not the messages that call them out for their hypocrisy, their falsehoods and their wickedness.
We should number our days realizing death comes to everyone unless we're alive when Jesus comes.
But in general, death comes to everyone. We should live as if we are definitely going, because we will, in one way or another face judgment.
Everyone of us, myself, you, all of us, everyone that has ever lived and ever will live, we will eventually face some kind of a judgment of God.
That doesn't mean that He will condemn us to hell or something like that, but rather we are judged, all of us, and some will be condemned to a burning fire that will annihilate them.
As the Bible teaches repeatedly and constantly. We'll all face a judgment, whether it's a judgment of reward of eternal life or the wages of sin being eternal death.
One or the other, we all will face a judgment. We need to not live life as if judgment is not coming, because it is to everyone eventually.
And especially to our generation. Very, very wicked, non-human generation.

Let's look at Psalm 33, verse 9.

And He spoke and they were made, the creation was made. He commanded it and they were created.
We know from Genesis 1, He spoke the world into existence. It did not take thousands of years for Him to make creation, but rather it was done.
Basically, in the snap of a finger, one word, two words, however many words He chose to use.
He spoke creation into existence. It only takes a second for the entire universe to change.
Not just Earth, but the entire universe can change in a second. Of course, there was changes for millions and billions of years.
There was changes, how the world did evolve. But there was an initial creation that was just God speaking things into existence.

It doesn't take long for drastic, major, worldwide, universal, historical, biblical proportion events to occur.
It doesn't take long. Whether it's while you're asleep or at work, washing dishes, eating, it's coming.
It came to Israel in the 1930s and 40s. It came to people in every generation. It happens in every generation. The Korean War, the Vietnam War, World War I, World War II, the Iraqi invasion, and now the Iranian War, and very soon the Gog Magog is equal to 38, invasion of America, of Taiwan, and of the United Kingdom and other nations.
And Israel, invasion of Israel. Look at Revelation 18. And this is one of the reasons why we should never, never, never have the mentality that, well, okay, I'll just wait until the second resurrection.
Since we do have that 100 years of Isaiah 65 verse 20, after the millennium, we do have that second life that Jesus himself spoke about, the second life of 100 years to get right if we don't make it in the first resurrection.
We should never have the mentality, well, I'll just wait until that second life and get saved in that life, live like the devil in this life, because there's still judgment coming in this life.

It may not be burning to death yet, because that happens after the second life. This is biblical, people, they hear this for the first time and they're like, okay, he is weird, this is strange, this is a lie, because they never read the entire Bible.
And if they did read it, they were programmed and brainwashed to twist it and distort it constantly.
Every page of the Bible, they were brainwashed to distort the Word of God. So they don't know the truth and don't recognize the truth when they hear it.

Very sad reality. But this second life, Jesus spoke about it. It's in Isaiah 65 verse 20, it's in Revelation 20, it's in the other chapter where Jesus spoke about it as well.

There's three examples right off the top of my head. It's there. I'm not talking about reincarnation. I'm not talking about Buddhism or Hinduism or New Age.

I'm talking about the Holy Scriptures, which is very unfamiliar to most Christians and pastors, very unfamiliar to past Christian pastors.

Very sad reality. But judgment is coming in this lifetime, in this age, in our timeframe, to the people that are alive right now.

Judgment is at the door right now. Judgment is at the door right now. So it is the day of salvation, although there are another day of salvation coming.

People need salvation right now. People need salvation right now, and they need Jesus right now.

Revelation 18 verse 17, for in one hour such great wealth has been laid waste, talking about the destruction of Babylon, the city of NEOM in Saudi Arabia.

And every shipmaster, every passenger and sailor, and as many as make their living by the sea, stood at a distance, were crying out as they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, what is like that great city? They threw dust on their heads. Who does that? Middle Eastern people. Muslims, right? Not Americans, not New Yorkers. New Yorkers have never in their life and never will ever, in all of their existence, they would never throw dust on their heads.

That's a Middle Eastern culture, right? Babylon is not America, it's not New York.

Of course, the whole world is a Babylonian society, but specifically the city of Babylon of the Book of Revelation is, in Saudi Arabia, a desert where you have dust, where you have sand, where you can throw on you.

You know, around here we have red clay. Throw red clay on you, you know, in this way, in this context.

It's a different type of soil. This is a Middle Eastern city, Middle Eastern book, amen.

The Bible is a Middle Eastern book, amen. But in one hour, verse 17, it only takes that this city is destroyed.

Don't take weeks or months. It comes suddenly, it comes quickly, and this is a huge, huge city because actually it's all the way from Mecca, which is the middle of the coast of Saudi Arabia, hundreds of miles north all the way up to the Israeli border and probably now would include even Gaza, or would have included Gaza, but now it won't because they ain't got time for that.

But it's multiple cities that are combined together, just like New York City is the city of Queens and Brooklyn and Manhattan and other cities combined into one, New York City.

So is the same with NEOM in Saudi Arabia. Multiple cities combined together. It doesn't take long for a huge metro city to be destroyed. New York City, their destruction has come in years before this.

The people that think New York is Babylon, they're not expecting what we're expecting.

They don't see what we see, and that is New York City, millions of people will be destroyed before, years before this event.

After this event of Revelation 18, when Babylon is destroyed, different time frame, years difference, three and a half years difference.

Go to Matthew 25, verse 13. Be on the alert then, for you do not know the day nor that I am talking about his coming. Again, Christians have been taught to distort this, to think, believe, and teach from the pulpit that even his own bride will not expect his coming, that she'll even be shocked and surprised about the coming of the Lord.

Therefore, that's pre-trib rapture foolishness. But the reality is that the people of New York City but the reality is that throughout scripture it teaches us to not be caught unprepared.

It teaches that, to not be caught unprepared or unaware and not watching and not waiting.

That's very easily proven. We've done scriptures, we've read those scriptures, we've read the scriptures, we've done sermons and we have read those scriptures a million times here but they never read it once.

They never read those verses because they've exposed their false doctrine. But the point of this verse here for us in the context of today's message is to the world a sudden destruction is coming unexpected.

That's very appropriate for Purim, for today and tomorrow is that the world is not expecting what is coming.

But we, going forward, whether the prophecy really is fulfilled tomorrow or not, our mentality should never change. What I've been teaching for 20 years and what I'm teaching today and what I will be teaching next weekend and the next weekend and the next weekend and the next new moon and the next holy day for the next three and a half years should never change.

What I'm saying is this, you need to maintain the same mentality and not change your mentality.

I'm talking about the fateful. Now, the people that are not fateful, of course, they need to change their mentality.

The people that are not expecting the destruction, they need to change their mentality to expect judgment, to expect a numbering of your days, to expect that your mortal death is coming, judgment is coming, great tribulation is coming, and you need to start paying attention to the news and start listening to the Word of God and start reading and studying the scripture and so much more. Amen.

The list is endless what those people need to do to change their mentality and their lives.

But specifically to the people that already believe the messages of Jesus Christ that have been delivered through me, even as the Apostle Paul said, that's not prideful to say that, it's not proudful to say when it's true, even as Paul said, the messages that Jesus delivered through him.

But to those people that already believe God's messages, God's Word delivered through me, even as had been delivered

through Jeremiah, Daniel, Paul, and so forth, you need to maintain the mentality of fatefulness, faith, not lose faith, remain faithful, persevere, focus on the finish line, rather the finish line is tomorrow, three years and a half, ten years, a thousand and one hundred years.

Focus on the finish line with faithfulness, faith, not lose faith, with faithfulness, obedience to God, maintaining the mentality of we could better prepare even yet and every day is a blessing, every day, every month, and every year is a blessing and a gift from God. Amen.

Amen. Praise Jesus.

Look at the previous chapter, Matthew 24, verse 13. But the one who abides, endures, perseveres in Jesus until the end, that person will be saved.

It's not talking about physical survival. It's talking about remaining in faithfulness, perseverance and faith spiritually, mentally, emotionally, that we cannot allow tribulation, troubles, despair, depression.

We cannot allow worries and fears to interfere with our faithfulness. We have to hold strongly tight to our confession of faith and our life of faith, our belief, our hope, our faith.

Our hope, our refuge, Christ Jesus, His name, His prophecies. His prophecies will be fulfilled whether it's this year or another year.

We're expecting tomorrow. If it doesn't happen, it still will be fulfilled. It still will be fulfilled. It will still come.

We have to endure until the end. The end is the day you're turned to Spirit, whether that's at the first resurrection or the end of the hundred years after the millennium, the second life.

Whichever time frame that you are turned to Spirit, that's the end. That's the finish line.

We're not finished until we're finished. We're not finished until the fat lady sings, right?

So it's not over until it's over with. And we have to endure, persevere until the very end in which we are turned to Spirit.

And if we make it in the first resurrection, then we are blessed because then those that partake in the first resurrection, death, cannot take hold of us.

But even if we have to make it in the second resurrection, as long as we make it in, we have to endure until the end.

Let's go to 1 Peter chapter 5, verse 8.

Be sensible, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. But resist him, firm in faith, knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being accomplished by your brethren who are in the world.

After you have suffered for a little while, the Theos of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in the Messiah, will himself perfect, confirm, strengthen, and establish you.

To him be dominion forever and ever. This is the truth. Amen. Praise God. God is so good to us. In verse 8, there's all kinds of temptation, tribulation, attack, persecution, mocking, laughter, unbelief, spiritual warfare against us.

But verse 9, we have to resist all of that and stand firm in faith, knowing that these sufferings are perfecting us, making us stronger, bolder, more courageous, less wimpy, less effeminate, less soft.

We're developing what that Bible calls the forehead of flint, a forehead of stone, a forehead that is hard, that's not soft and cushiony, that is not wimpy, that doesn't cry over everything.

And women need to apply this as well. All of us, men and women, need to be stronger.

Had that one sermon to buckle up, buttercup, not be so soft, be able to handle adult language, firmness, firmness of voice, not be immature in that way, be able to handle adult, adult subjects, strong, firm authority.

Jesus spoke with authority, taught with authority. The Bible says that. It says people were surprised by it. Just like people are surprised by it today.

They're used to the soft touch, being babyfied, pacified. But God has dominion, authority.

His church is his kingdom. His church is his government. With church, with organization, with structure, with administration. Because that's opposite of chaos.

If you don't have administration and government and authority, then you have chaos.

Then you have false doctrine and you have darkness and you have weakness. We're the army of the Lord.

Army has organization and structure and authority, not chaos. God is not the author of chaos.

Let's go to the book of Luke, chapter 12, verse 42.

And the Lord said, Who then is the faithful and wise steward, whom his master would put in charge of his servants, to

give them their rations at the proper time?

Fulfilled or serene is that slave whom his master finds so doing when he comes. I'll tell you the truth that he'll put him in charge of all of his possessions.

But if that slave says in his heart, my master will be a long time in coming, and begins to beat the slaves, men and women, into eating, drinking, get drunk.

I'm talking about a regular basis of drunkenness, of alcoholism, of gluttony, of not caring about when the Lord is coming, but just a careless wasted life.

Then the master of that slave will come on a day when he does not expect an hour that he does not know, and will cut him to pieces and assign him a place with the unbelievers.

But that slave who knew his master's will, and did not get ready, or act in accord of his will, will receive many lashes. But the one that did not know, and committed works worthy of a flogging, will receive but few.

But everyone who has been given much, much will be required, and to whom they have entrusted much, or of him they will ask all the more.

So this also confirms my thinking and policy as well about the people that have known about this ministry for years, and then after the strong delusion actually is fulfilled, and then they start coming back, I will not spend much time with them at all.

One email max probably, and I will not take them back, because they've had ample opportunity, they've had years to repent, to return, but rather because to whom much has been given, much is expected, and much is required.

And they suffer the worst judgment according to these verses. They suffered the worst judgment.

They heard my preaching. They heard the messages delivered through me. They heard the Word of God. They heard the truth more than billions of other people on the earth.

And they still did not remain faithful to stay in God's Church. They are unworthy of safety, protection, deliverance, rescue, favor, but they are worthy of the judgment of God.

But those people that have not heard of this ministry until now, those are the people that I will give more time to, and God will show more mercy to, because they have not had the same opportunity yet that the others had.

Another verse that backs that up is where Jesus talked about those cities that He had traveled to and done miracles in, and they did not repent and they did not believe.

And He said that it's going to be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrah than it will be for those cities, because those cities saw the Lord.

They received the messages of the Lord. They saw the miracles, and they still did not follow Him or believe or repent. So they're worthy of greater judgment than Solomon and Galore, because at least Solomon and Galore, they didn't have as much opportunity to know and learn the truth.

I guess the law wasn't doing very much work there. They didn't have much opportunity.

They didn't see the Lord before the Day of Judgment. Let's go to Hebrews 10. Page 781. And I do encourage people that as soon as you realize that we are God's Church right here, I would encourage you to immediately, immediately order the Alpha and Omega paperback so that you can receive the most accurate translation of Scripture and learn faster and quicker, and you've got to be in that Bible every day in a huge magnitude of reading the Bible and learning and growing.

Girls, you have a very, very extremely short period of time left, and you're going to have to press hard.

I would recommend that people that are just now learning about this ministry this week, I would recommend that you immediately quit your jobs so that you can spend every moment that you can, every hour, every minute that you can possibly put into reading the Scriptures, reading all the articles of this ministry, listening to previous sermons, and learning as quickly and fast as you can because judgment is at the door, and you have a very little, very small window of opportunity to learn the messages of Jesus Christ delivered through this ministry.

So to those people I'd recommend you quit your job, immediately quit your job, and put your every fiber of being into serving the Lord and learning because you're not going to have a job very much longer anyway.

You're not going to have a house, a home, a family, friends, money, water, electricity, warmth, shelter, food.

You're not going to have anything much longer anyway, regardless. So you may as well take what little bit of time you've got left to learn the Word of God and repent and be baptized in Jesus' name with this ministry and surrender to God and save your life by losing your life, by surrendering everything in your life, giving it all up, surrendering your life so that you may gain eternal life.

This is the message Jesus told when he traveled. Absolutely. This is what Jesus told. And this is the only appropriate

message for this context of time we're living in right now, is total surrender and total devotion.

In the context of what little bit of time we've got left, anything less than this is not true salvation, and it's not true following Christ or being a true Christian.

It is time to be crucified. It is time for martyrdom. It is time to take your place in history and give up everything you have, everything you own, and leave your parents and leave your husbands and leave your wives and leave your dogs and cats and come and serve the Lord in this place of Noah's Ark and serve the Lord Jesus Christ with all of your heart, with all of your mind, without any distractions, without any hindrances, to quickly lay aside every weight that holds you back, that hinders you, and press forward with all of your strength, with all of your being, with all of your energy, with all of your attention.

It's not time now to have children or to get married. It's not time for the luxuries of life.

It's not time for physical pleasures. It is time for battle. It is time for war. It is time for the door of Noah's Ark to close.

Here in Hebrews 10, verse 23. Let us hold very tight unto the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who has promised is faithful.

So let us consider one another to provoke and to love and to good works, not forsaking or gathering together as is the habit of some, but encourage one another even as more as the day draws near.

For if it continues to sin willfully after we have and accepted the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins.

So there's people that heard the truth, accepted the truth, tasted the truth, tasted the Holy Ghost, got baptized in this ministry, and have fallen away, was part of the apostasy, was part of the great falling away of 2 Thessalonians 2, there no longer remains a sacrifice of sins for you.

You're dead. And I will let the dead bury the dead. Amen? I will allow the dead to bury their dead.

They're already dead. They might as well bury their dead. If they walk among the dead, they are zombies to me. And we need to work with and focus only on people, only on people that as well need to give up anything and everything. Luke 14, what, verse 26? I need help. Come on, I need help. 28? No, verse 26. So we need people that will devote themselves. Amen?

Now let's go to Philippians, chapter 3, verse 14. I pursue toward the goal for the prize of the high calling of Theos and the Messiah Jesus. Amen?

Let's go back to verse 12. Not that I have already obtained it or already become perfected, but I press on or squeeze so that I may seize upon it that which also I was seized by, Messiah Jesus.

Brethren, I do not regard myself for having already seized it yet. But one thing I do, forgetting what lies behind me, like Noah's, not Noah's us, Lot's wife looked behind, but forgetting what lies behind and reaching forward to what lies ahead.

Finish line, amen? I pursue toward the goal, finish line, for the prize of the high calling of Theos and Messiah Jesus.

Let us therefore, as many who have been perfected, have this attitude that we have not yet perfected ourselves. Amen?

So, we've got to press toward the mark. We've got to press. Faith requires movement, pushing through the resistance, through the Babylonian culture, through spiritual warfare, through temptation, trials and tribulations, through all the mocking and persecution, through doubt and self-fears and self-doubts, through depression, through pain, through everything, to press through, to not let anything hinder you, but lay aside every weight that so hinders you, whether it's husband, wife, child, or parent, or grandparent, brother or sister, or money or a job. Amen?

Faith requires movement. Faith does require movement. Amen. If the world can change in one second, then we must live every second ready, rooted in truth, anchored in faith, and watching for the great tribulation, and then afterward the return of Christ after the end of the great tribulation.

One of the lessons of Purim is that God promises us the ultimate victory, not the immediate victory, but the ultimate victory at the end.

The only to the faithful who continue to maintain in faith and faithfulness long-suffering, perseverance, preserving until the end, and maintain preparedness and obedience to Christ, maintain participation in the body of Christ as each member of the body has to do a function.

If any one member of the body of Christ does not function, do something, then the whole body suffers.

If your kidney is weak, if your liver is weak, if your liver stops working, if your kidney stops working, or if you have a bone in your body that is starting to decay, whatever, it hurts the whole body, disease spreads.

Every member of the body of Christ needs to be participating, clicking like, and commenting, and sharing, all three, on Twitter, on Facebook.

And I don't want to hear excuses. I don't like Facebook. I'm not on Facebook. I don't like Twitter.

I don't want to be on Twitter. Bullshit. Get off your lazy ass and start participating. Join.

You might have to create a new email. You might have to buy a second phone to get a second phone number.

Whatever you have to do, do it so that you can join Facebook and Twitter, now called X, and comment on every one of my posts.

Click like or heart on every one of my posts, and share every one of my posts. Why am I so adamant about this?

Because time is running out, and it is urgent and beyond extremely important to get the messages of God Almighty to these people that have not yet heard His messages.

It can't be more important. It can't be more important. It is of importance of a thousand percent. It is urgent.

It is important. It only takes five to ten minutes a day. That's all it takes to go through my Twitter posts of that day at the end of the night or first thing in the morning, whether you want to do it at night or morning, either one, to go through those posts and go click, click, click, click, amen, amen, amen, share, share, share, and then go to Facebook and do the same thing.

Ten minutes, maybe fifteen minutes max per day. And people act like that I'm asking you to do a thousand jumping jacks, or a thousand sit-ups, or a thousand push-ups.

I'm not asking anything that's hard or difficult or even dangerous.

People are so paranoid that the government is going to come and arrest them if they join Facebook, or if they post, or if they click share, or if they click a heart.

"Oh, my God, the government's going to come and arrest me, and I will be thrown into a concentration camp because I'm exposing myself on social media."

The truth is, they already know your name and where you live, your driver's license, your social security number.

They already know who you are, where you live, and every piece of mail that you receive and every piece of mail you send out is recorded in a computer.

That's fact. That is fact. Even to send or receive even a letter or a package in the mail, either one, is recorded in a computer, every one of them.

Who sent it and where it came from, where, when, and how, and where, date and time, even what time of day.

People need to stop being paranoid and start working for the Lord. Participation in the evangelism, the gospel, sharing the messages of Christ being sent through this ministry, every part of the body has got to be part of this evangelism.

I depend upon every member of his church, every member, every member. I am depending upon you in this very urgent hour and we're running out of time, so it's much more important now than what it was two years ago.

There is such a thing as using a VPN. There is such a thing as using a fake name.

And even if you do end up having to use your real name, again, they already have that information and where you live, every letter you have sent out, everything, every email you sent.

They already know all that. And besides, martyrdom is coming anyway.

We're expecting Bashar Assad of Syria to manifest as the Antichrist to the world tomorrow, March 4th.

We're expecting Bashar to manifest as the Antichrist to the world tomorrow, March 4th, 2026, Purim.

This would be the opening of the fifth seal of the book of Revelation, Chapter 6.

This would be part of a major war in Heaven and on Earth. Now, it's amazing because last night it was already Purim in Israel because they do sunset to sunset, plus they're several hours ahead of us as well.

So both of those facts, they were already in Purim. On the day of this total lunar eclipse, they started their ground invasion of Lebanon and Hezbollah.

Now, Lebanon is very important in the Bible. It's written many, many, many times in scriptures.

And it says that the Prince of Tyrus may have, I may be sounding that wrong, and I may even have a wrong town even, but it talks about that, and that's Lebanon and that's where Satan was.

And in addition to Revelation 2 and 3, it's a different place. And this Lebanon and Hezbollah, Hezbollah is the army of Assad.

So it's very relevant that this happened on Purim. The ground invasion of Hezbollah and Lebanon is extremely, extremely significant to happen on Purim.

And the first day of Purim, the day of the lunar eclipse, very extremely significant.

We cannot sniff at this. This is not a light thing, but this is huge. This is very, extremely huge. And we can expect today and tonight for there to be a major quickening, a huge increase in war in Lebanon and as well as Syria.

We can start watching Syria. Syria cannot talk and we're out, we're exhausted. Barely talked, so exhausted. But Syria, we need to keep our eyes on.

Also, the hydro-electrical dams in the United States. We need to keep our eyes on.

These prophecies are going to start being fulfilled. Where there's a lot to watch over the next 24 and 48 hours, a lot to watch.

Now, the lunar eclipse just discovered this morning that President Trump was born during a partial lunar eclipse.

Trump was born. And also Prime Minister of Israel Benjamin, try to pronounce his name, Netanyahu.

He was born during a solar eclipse. And the Ayatollah Khomeini that they just supposedly probably killed a few days ago in Iran, the ex-so-called supreme leader of Iran, he was born during a solar eclipse.

Trump, Khomeini, and Netanyahu, all three of those world leaders that were involved in this war were all born during eclipses.

And that's verified and that's confirmed. Now, some people would try to say the path of the eclipse is not over the location of their births.

And that's true, but is not worthy of bringing up because an eclipse is something that happens in the universe between the sun and the earth or the moon and the earth or the moon and the sun and the earth, whatever.

And it doesn't matter where the path is on the earth, it's still occurring in the universe.

It's still an eclipse in the universe. It's still an eclipse between these global huge, gigantic global bodies.

So where the path is really is a useless point. That doesn't remove the fact that they were born, all three of them, on the dates of eclipses.

For all three to be born, not just one or two, but all three of those world leaders that were the most connected to this particular battle, to this particular war, for all three of those to be born during eclipses and then for this time to have an eclipse during this war.

That is not a light thing. That is not a small thing. If you combine that with the ground invasion from Israel to Lebanon on the date of the eclipse, combine that with the fact all three of those world leaders of this war were born during eclipse, then that's beyond coincidence.

You combine all of that, that's beyond coincidence. And it also proves that astrology is real and true, that we were born, everybody, you and me, everybody was born during whatever planetary alignment, planetary situation, positions in the universe that do affect world events and who you are as a person, your character, your personality, the year, date, and location of your birth are very much part of who you are.

And a lot of people would immediately jump to a conclusion based upon false religion and false doctrines and false teachers and false churches and false denominations and what they have been brainwashed and programmed with. They would immediately say, you're teaching witchcraft, you're of the devil, all that crap.

But when you look at the facts of all three world leaders were born during eclipse, and then we have this war during eclipse and the ground invasion of Lebanon during the eclipse, you add all that up, that's beyond coincidence, and you cannot deny, you cannot deny if you have even a quarter of a brain, you cannot deny the reality, the fact of the relationship of the planetary bodies with the events on earth and the people, the people and their birth, the time of their birth, their date of their birth, you cannot deny these.

These are facts that you cannot deny. So if we can't deny these facts, then the lie is the religion that taught you that it's witchcraft or demonic to declare the position of the global bodies at your time and date of birth.

That's the lie because we cannot deny that these men were born during these global positions.

The lie is religion, their religion, false religion, false Christianity that says everything is a sin, everything is a sin, everything is a sin, everything is a sin except for what is sin, and then that's not a sin to them.

They have everything backwards, everything, just about. They probably only have like five percent correct out of all their teachings.

A wild guess of percentages is a very small, little, tiny percentage of their teachings that they have correct.

Now, we are expecting Assad to manifest tomorrow on Purim as the Antichrist to the world, and major war today, tonight, tomorrow, major war, huge war, much more than what we're seeing right now, a major increase because there's going to be a fake battle of Armageddon.

Because there's going to be a fake battle of Armageddon when Assad appears, war in heaven, Revelation 12.

Now, if, however, if the Heavenly Father, Almighty, Alpha, and Omega, if He decides for any reason to delay another year or so, then so be it.

I can't tell God what to do and what not to do and when He can do it, when He can't do it.

He's God, not me. If He decides to delay another year or so, which we don't expect, but if that happens, if He does delay, then we still need to maintain faith in the truth.

Every individual doctrine, every individual teaching must be examined on its own merit.

What does the Bible say and what does it not say on the Sabbath, heaven, and hell, their extra actions?

Life and death, doctrine, commandments, every doctrine rests on its own merits. And we must maintain truth and faithfulness, perseverance and preparedness, obedience to Christ, obedience to His commandments, and not become deluded with a delay that God would give us a gift, a heavenly gift of more time.

I've seen in my 20 years of preaching, I have seen pastors and Christians that were in the truth.

There was actually a pastor in Mexico one time that accepted all my teachings. But yet something happened, a death in his family, I forget what it was, but something happened, and all of a sudden, without any warning at all, without any warning, without telling me that he was second-guessing the existence of God, all of a sudden, the next email or next message was, I no longer believe in God.

I'm an atheist. Just because a tribulation came. Amen? Just because a tribulation came.

That's life. And that's stupidity, to give up on God after you have already accepted and acknowledged great truth.

That's just stupidity, and he deserves the harshest punishment that God can deliver him.

He does, he deserves the most harshest punishment, torture, for days on end. For to have tasted the Word of God in the magnitude that he tasted and then trampled God underfoot, it is that type of people that I will not have patience for, and neither will God, and they will suffer the damnation.

We must be patient, we must maintain faithfulness, even when trial comes. Amen? Trial should make us more faithful, not less faithful. If it does not happen this time, I will have no regrets, none.

I shared what I was seeing in world events, very real and true events all year long and in the previous days and weeks, and we are currently in a very historic major war on Purim, and saw the invasion of Lebanon on Purim.

That's huge. That is nothing to discount. That is a fulfillment, that is a huge major event. War with Iran is a major event during Purim, and invasion of Lebanon is a major event, so two major events already, already, and we're not even done with Purim.

So even if we get past Purim without a strong delusion, which I highly doubt that if, if God Almighty of His own will decides to delay, we still had a huge major multiple fulfillments on Purim, which would foreshadow another major huge event in a future Purim.

The reason I say what if is because, hey, I'm not God, I'm human, and I cannot dictate God's mind and God's actions. He can do anything He wants to do. He is God Almighty, and He will move what He will move, and He'll do what He would do.

He's the boss. Amen. But I expect that war in heaven tonight. And then there's also, I'm pretty sure, probably even a March 5th Purim in Iran, because different Bible talks about, and history talks about, how different cities and nations and groups and sects, how they calculate calendars different and how they observe holy days different, and then you got your time zones as well and so forth.

But there is a March 5th Purim as well, probably, to some groups. But I'm expecting that tomorrow on the 4th.

But I'm just laying out every possibility, because I don't always know every little detail of what God's going to do.

A lot of people think a prophet should know everything, in perfection, and that's very silly to think that way.

But that's the way most people think, that a prophet should know every little tiny detail of everything, and everything has to be perfectly declared, no doubt.

But the reality is God only reveals so much, even to His prophets. Even Daniel did not understand.

Even Jeremiah didn't know it all, even Joseph and even Adam. I mean Noah and Paul, all these different people called of God, children of God, true men of God, none of them understood everything.

None of them. We only understand so much, being human, being in the flesh, that God is great to reveal what He has revealed.

Anybody want to say anything yet, before we put on the song?

Jared: "One of the things that I learned, the major thing with coming into the truth, this ministry, is that the holy days and the new moons are still to be observed.

So you have, in the year 52 Sabbaths, about 30 holy days, counting the seven, eight-day feasts.

And the holy days are still to be observed.”

The seven, eight-day feasts. And 12 or 13 new moons, some overlap with the Sabbaths.

That's 30 holy days that most of the world doesn't even know about.

Without the new moons. And then 12 more with the New Moons, so it would be 42.

42 maybe, because sometimes you have a new moon, so it's not an exact number. But between I'd say 38 to 42 holy days and counting the new moons for a year.

And then that's not counting the weekly Sabbaths either.

Or even three months counting the Sabbaths.

Yeah, it's about 90 holy days per year total on average, counting all annual Sabbaths, High holy days, New Moons and weekly Sabbaths. Total around 90. One in four days on average. That's amazing. Around 90 days a year. Three months out of 12. So that's a percentage of

25% of the year has been designated, set apart as holy days for God.

That's very significant, a quarter of the year, 25% of the year, the false Christians, most of them, don't observe.

And most of the world don't observe. The Roman Catholic Church does not observe. So that's mind-boggling. That's a great point.

That's a great point. Wonderful point. Thank you Jared.
